School Supply List 2021-2022

Grade Two

To assist you in purchasing school supplies for your child we have prepared this list of materials for your consideration:

1	Courier/message bag with zipper (can be purchased at Dollarama, about 10 X 13" in size)
3	Crayons - pack of 24 (Crayola is best, and often the lowest price)
1	Pack of washable, thin tip, classic colours markers (preferably Crayola)
24	Sharpened pencils (Dollar store brand are NOT recommended as they do not sharpen well. Ticonderoga and Staedtler are two reliable brands. Please do not buy pencils with a latex or plastic coating over the wood---these ruin the pencil sharpeners. Thanks.)
1	1" plastic binder (hard cover, white with a plastic insert on the front, if possible.)
1	Hard sided plastic pencil case (a plain box with no dividers is best)
2-3	White erasers
1	Pair of scissors (with metal blades)
2	Glue sticks -40g (the small ones do not last long)
1	Package of 4 lined scribblers (Hilroy or Canadiana are two good brands)
1	Package of 10 clear page protectors
2 -3	Whiteboard markers (black and blue are best)
1	Sketchbook for art--about 9 X 12" (Not an expensive one, please. Dollarama carries a sketch pad for about \$2.)

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and the circumstances and uncertainty it has caused, we are providing you with a minimal and basic list of school supplies.

- Please reuse previous year supplies if you can - no need to buy new if you have items that are in usable condition
- It is not necessary to provide quantities of requested items for the entire school year on the first day of school.
- If you are able to shop the back-to-school sales in August/September, you will find prices much lower than they will be later in the year, especially for basic items.

Your child may be able to reuse last year's backpack--that's great! If you are going to be purchasing a new backpack, however, be sure that it is large enough to hold the courier bag mentioned above, as well as your child's lunch bag, water bottle, change of clothes, sweater, etc.. A large backpack is actually easier for your child to manage than a too-small one, and the zipper will last longer. :-)
