## Student Success Planning

- Gr. 2 reading priority
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  - → Now: 273 students, 239 meeting, 34 not meeting
  - → Beth Stuart (literacy coach, literacy student support) renewed until end of year
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  - → Literacy program based on phonics and sound-based learning for reading
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  - → Colleagues at other schools invited some of our teachers in to view it in action
  - → SLP was part of it as well to add to her programming

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- Registration is high for next year
  - → 19 English, 8 French Immersion
  - → Job assignments went out last week. Many of those will change by September.
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  - → Pre-Primary moving to 117 Kearney Lake Road. Unsure if this is one year, or multiple years plan.
- CUPE Job Action
  - → Connected with families who are unable to be at school without EPA support. They are being supported with their learning at home.
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- Dates for school bookings for next year need to be chosen by May
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  - → Ex. Halloween Dance, etc.
